Coach Devlin begins his 4th season as Head Coach of the Archbishop Wood High School Football program. This past season he led the Vikings to the State Semi-Finals Game in Hershey and in 2008 to the PIAA State Finals while winning The Philadelphia Catholic League and District 12 Championships. He was voted as the Nike AAA State Coach of the Year and The Philadelphia Eagles High School Coach of the Week. He was selected as the 2007 and 2009 Philadelphia Catholic League Coach of the Year. Prior to Wood he served as the Assistant Head Coach at St. Joseph's Prep where they won multiple Catholic League Championships and built a program that was recognized nationally.
